A few thoughts on my initial Google Search Generative Experience (SGE) Tests [Updated]

I just got access to Google's Search Lab, and after testing Google's SGE for a couple of hours, here are my initial thoughts.


TL;DR:

- o SGE's snapshots content can be repetitive with those included in search features, such as double map packs
- o Lists of resources included in the SGE's that I tried were not clickable, giving a bad experience
- o Some SGE's snapshots of complex topics were rather simplistic and didn't really fulfill the need, looking more like Featured Snippets on steroids. It didn't make any sense to add them there.
- o Some of the inclusions in SGE's snapshots didn't align with the intent of the query, eg. informational answer to commercial query; making it not very useful
- o When searching for products categories for which Google already provided a "product carousel!" in search results along with product listings pages (categories, subcategories, facets, etc.), they also provided a similar expanded product carousel experience in the snapshot -making it clickable, showing the product knowledge panel when clicking on it-. Besides being repetitive, if this design is kept, due to the product carousel expanded visibility and "click" behavior, it will likely shift the traffic now going go product lists to product detail pages.
- o For branded commercial queries, like Nike Sneakers or North Face Hoodie: Established Brand retailers PLPs will lose organic search traffic that *won't* likely only go to their own PDPs (!) but also to other online stores offering the product, since Google is generating a PLP like experience in the SGE snapshot directly, with an overall product description and showing the relevant brand products directly there in a clickable product carousel like format... but when you click on any of the brand products, it shows a product knowledge panel that won't only show results from the PDPs of the "brand" site, it will show also PDPs from any online stores/distributors/etc. that also offer those brand products and optimize their feeds/structured data well to appear there.


Let's go through these!

2. For broader commercial queries like "Caribbean Cruise", "Men's Jeans" or "Mass Payout Solution"

For "Caribbean cruise" which is ranked in top positions by the cruise line with the name, a mix of cruise lines relevant destination pages and travel/cruise sites listings with offers, the choice to feature in the SGE a rather informational summary about the topic instead of a more commercial oriented one is rather weird, and not so useful. Then they "squeeze" in the right carousel a lot of informational resources, which are *not* ranking in top positions.

At Google, we've long believed in the power of AI to transform the ability to deliver helpful information. In this post, we'll share more about how AI-generated content fits into our long-standing approach to show helpful content to people on Search.

Rewarding high-quality content, however it is produced

Google's ranking systems aim to reward original, high-quality content that demonstrates qualities of what we call E-E-A-T: expertise, experience, authoritativeness, and trustworthiness. We share more about this [in our How Search Works site](#).

Our focus on the quality of content, rather than how content is produced, is a useful guide that has helped us deliver reliable, high quality results to users for years.

For example, about 10 years ago, there were understandable concerns about a rise in mass-produced yet human-generated content. No one would have thought it reasonable for us to declare a ban on all human-generated content in response. Instead, it made more sense to improve our systems to reward quality content, [as we did](#).

Focusing on rewarding quality content has been core to Google since we began. It continues today, including through our [ranking systems](#) designed to [surface reliable information](#) and our [helpful content system](#). The helpful content system was introduced last year to better ensure those searching get content created primarily for people, rather than for search ranking purposes.

How automation can create helpful content

When it comes to automatically generated content, our guidance has been consistent for years. Using automation—including AI—to generate content with the primary purpose of manipulating ranking in search results is a [violation of our spam policies](#).

Google has many years of experience dealing with automation being used in an attempt to game search results. Our spam-fighting efforts—including our [SpamBrain system](#)—will continue, however spam is produced.

This said, it's important to recognize that not all use of automation, including AI generation, is spam. Automation has long been used to generate helpful content, such as sports scores, weather forecasts, and transcripts. AI has the ability to power new levels of expression and creativity, and to serve as a critical tool to help people create great content for the web.

FAQ

To further help, here are some answers to questions you may have about AI content and Google Search:

Is AI content against Google Search's guidelines?

Appropriate use of AI or automation is not against our guidelines. This means that it is not used to generate content primarily to manipulate search rankings, which is [against our spam policies](#).

Should I use AI to generate content?

If you see AI as an essential way to help you produce content that is helpful and original, it might be useful to consider. If you see AI as an inexpensive, easy way to game search engine rankings, then no.







ChatGPT for SEO: 20 Ways to Leverage ChatGPT in your SEO Activities

The release of **ChatGPT by OpenAI** (chatbot built on top of OpenAI's GPT-3.5 that interacts in a conversational way) at the end of last month became a **tipping point for AI** that took the world, including the SEO industry, by storm due to the comprehensiveness and quality of answers, even **making Google's management to issue a 'code red'** due to its rising popularity to look for information.

However, it's important to be aware of its limitations, many of which **were explained at the time of its release**, and in **this** and **this** comprehensive guides covering ChatGPT by Roger Montti, like not being aware of content created after 2021, built-in biases, and ultimately, the fact that featuring purely AI generated content violates Google's guidelines.

Specifically, Barry Schwartz covered how when asked about "Using AI to plagiarize the content, modify it, and then outrank in search results?" **Google has mentioned that:**

« *Scraping content, even with some modification, is against our spam policy.*» Duy added that Google has "many algorithms to go after such behaviors and demote site scraping content from other sites." »

Recommendation: Understand the *why* of SEO tasks, become strategical, this is what ultimately drives real value in SEO processes.

Also, SEO stops being a "knowledge" problem and starts becoming an "execution" challenge very quickly in many bigger processes in bureaucratic scenarios/organizations. SEOs capacity to communicate, influence and coordinate stakeholders, as well as other "soft skills" become core to the success of the project in these cases.
